

## **Investment Programme Manager – Surface Transport, TFL** **£60 - £75k + excellent benefits** **London**

Transport for London (TfL) helps millions travel through the Capital every day – whether that's by car, boat, train, tram or Tube. Its Surface Transport division manages everything that's not rail or underground related, including the congestion charge, bus routes, taxis, and cycle paths.

### **Your role**

You'll be based in the Surface Programme Management Office (SPMO), which oversees the delivery of an annual £350m investment programme for Surface Transport. There you'll produce monthly executive status reports on around 25 projects within the investment programme, each with a budget of £2m or above. You'll also be responsible for the assurance of those projects through a Gateway Review process. This information will be used to brief the MD of Surface Transport and then the Commissioner.

### **What you'll need**

This is a senior programme management role, requiring you to liaise closely with specific project teams to maximise the deliverability of the investment programme. So, as well as strong technical knowledge gained in civil or mechanical engineering, you'll need a broad range of project management experience and a good understanding of the business planning process – including capacity planning, business plan deployment and benefits realisation. You'll also need to be:

- educated to degree level or equivalent with an MBA or other post grad qualification
- professionally accredited (APM, PMI etc)
- Prince2 and MSP Practitioner qualified or have knowledge of similar methodologies.

### **Rewards**

The diversity and scope of the projects you'll be dealing with (and the fact many of them have fixed end dates) make this role highly attractive – especially with the 2012 Olympic and Paralympics Games just around the corner. Add in free Tube travel and a final salary pension scheme and it stands out even more.
